Drawing MHW-1 calls for a differential pressure controller to be located on the east wall by the LVR-1 dampers. As submitted, and approved, the control enclosure is rated NEMA 4X, and is not an explosion proof classified enclosure. We are requesting a relocation of this enclosure to an appropriate environment. We have two proposed locations, please advise.

- 1. On the other side of the wall from the defined location. This puts the enclosure on the exterior of the building.
- 2. In the electrical room next to the other differential pressure display enclosure.
