Lack of response by the General Contractor does not alleviate the contractor from their responsibilities during the construction phase to ensure those items noted have been addressed including:
 - The anchor bolts will be provided by the General Contractor in lieu of the equipment supplier and will meet the needs and requirements of the submitted equipment.
 - The prime paint provided on the equipment to be delivered to the project site will be compatible with the field finish paint by others.
- 3. The equipment supplier has indicated major control component cut sheets were provided in the prior shop submittal which we acknowledge. Numerous other control components were not included in the shop submittal. An indication of *No Exception Taken* to this shop submittal does not alleviate the Contractor from being fully responsible for providing all required control parts, pieces and components necessary for the equipment identified in Specification Sections
